- The winning entries will be chosen by a panel of judges. The panel will include professional English teachers and representatives from EAA and Futureminds International Education and Immigration Inc.
- The winners will be selected on **the following marking criteria: content, language, organization, creativity and other relevant criteria which judges think fit.**
- By entering 2022 Arch Cup CEWC, contestants grant EAA a universal, royalty-free, sub-licensable and transferable license to use all or any portion of their work without notification to them.
